The principles of COSHH course is a stand-alone course aimed at those who use substances hazardous to health at work. It introduces employees to the hazards associated with those substances, the risks and controls available and what to expect from a COSHH assessment. Successful completion will prepare employees to look carefully at their activities and contribute to the safer use of hazardous substances in co-operation with their managers and supervisors.

- Understanding of the responsibilities imposed by the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health Regulations 1999
